

They are invited to fill these banks with pennies, nickels, and dimes. The "fish" will be caught on Palm Sunday, April 2nd. For adults who would also like to "go fishing" with their spare change, they will find extra boxes on the counter in the church office. All the O.G.H.S. donations will go directly to PC-USA, specifically for earthquake victims.
