Reader: During the Advent Season, we lit four candles; three purple and one rose colored, for each Sunday before Christmas. On Christmas Eve, we light the white Christ candle.

Four Sundays ago, we lit the candle of Hope. Three Sundays ago, we lit the candle of Peace. Two Sundays ago, we lit the rose-colored candle: the candle of Joy. In this morning's worship, we lit the candle of Love.

Reader: Tonight, we light the Christ candle, remembering that Jesus was born in a manger. But we know that Jesus is the Lord of the world, and Savior of all of us.
