PENTECOST PC(USA) OFFERING: On Sunday, June 8, the Mission Committee is once again asking you to "pour out your spirit" and show "we are there" for the Presbyterian Mission Agency's annual Pentecost offering. This offering is dedicated to helping youth build a strong and solid foundation of faith not only within our own congregation and community but nationally and throughout the world. The money we collect will be divided four ways with 40% staying with us to support our own youth ministries, 25% going for the agency's Young Adult Volunteer programs, 25% helping to support national and international youth ministries and 10% going toward the "Educate a Child, Transform the World" national initiative. Last year, First Presbyterian collected \$1,328 with our share (\$498) being used to help support our annual Vacation Bible School/Camp program. The money raised this year will also be used for our VBS program.

<u>ROCK THE BLOCK:</u> Blue Water Habitat for Humanity will once again be "rocking the block" on **Saturday, June 28th,** and is looking for volunteers. The

nonprofit's annual outdoor beautification project will cover four blocks near 11th and Division streets on the city's South Side. Volunteers will be helping clean up yards and do minor outdoor repairs throughout the morning with lunch provided by First United Methodist Church.
